
The upper Zambezi River runs along Zimbabwe's border with Zambia for approximately 80 kilometres before plunging into a gorge as it falls over Victoria Falls (Mosi-oa-tunya). The Zambezi National Park protects a 50-kilometre stretch of the riverbank, covers 56,000 hectares and is where you will find Sian Simba River Lodge.













The lodge is in a fantastic location: only one hour from Victoria Falls and surrounded by wildlife with an elevated position on the edge of the Zambezi. Sitting on a wide bend in the river the lodge looks over the river from many directions with guest tents facing the river or surrounding bush.




