

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

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GENERAL INFORMATION

We will meet you at Maun Airport, introduce you to your pilot before you depart on an amazing 25min scenic flight to Oddballs Camp deep in the Okavango.


Oddballs' Camp is situated on the edge of Chief's Island, deep in the heart of the Okavango Delta, and is the Okavango Delta's most affordable camp. All activities are led by men from the local communities.

On arrival, you are met at the airstrip by your personal guide and welcomed to the island. He remains your guide for the duration of your stay.










This family-oriented camp offers guests a high standard of comfort whilst being one of the Okavango's most affordable camps and immersing guests in a true Delta experience.

Game of all sorts are abundant: lion, leopard, buffalo, elephant, hippopotamus, crocodile, giraffe, antelope including the rare lechwe, tsessesbe and sitatunga, otters, honey-badgers, a variety of the smaller wild cats such as civets, servals and genets are amongst the many mammal species that visit the Delta.

ACCOMODATION

The camp accommodates 28 guests in 14 3m x 3m canvas rooms (including two family units), thoughtfully created and set on elevated wooden decks shaded by the trees and canvas shelters.

Beautiful outdoor showers and ablutions en-suite offer hot and cold running water for a traditional al-fresco bucket shower. A small deck offers a place to relax and view the stunning scenery.





MEALS

There are flexible mealtimes to accommodate sightings and Oddball's Camp is happy to accommodate alternative family dining times and to prepare simple food for children. Coffee and tea is always available.

The morning starts off with an early rise, after which coffee and snacks are available before guests head out for the first activity. Once back at camp, you are greeted with a hearty, full breakfast before the siesta period of relaxation. Following lunch, the guests will departure on their late afternoon activity in the cooler afternoon. The day is ended with a dinner at the dining hall where guests can mingle.









ACTIVITIES:

Oddballs' offers no motorized activities. Each guide has his own mokoro (pl. mekoro), in which he'll take guests gliding through the Okavango to nearby islands (water dependent). Guests then continue on foot through the magnificent scenery to view wildlife, birds, insects, medicinal plants, tracks, signs, droppings, and other fascinating natural phenomena. The luxury of being privately guided allows guests to focus on their particular interests and to determine how it is that they would like to spend each day.



FACILITIES

Relax on the satellite viewing deck or chill zone with hammocks in your free time. Mingle with other guests in the common area and sitting room or try spot some wildlife from camp at the raised viewing deck over the Boro River.

Oddball's also has a small library, chess and selection of games to keep guests entertained.

-Please be advised that the use of mekoro depends on a number of factors beyond the camp's control — water levels, vegetation growth, changes in the Okavango's channel-structure, and hippo activity, amongst others. These can and do change quickly and unpredictably. Consequently Delta Camp may not be able to offer mokoro excursions due to practical constraints or safety considerations. If this is the case they recommend guests participate in other activities that are equally enriching and complete a full-bodied safari experience.

CHILDREN

Oddballs' loves them! They have two family units and no age restrictions. They believe that guests know their children and as they will not be doing any excursions in the company of other guests they have only themselves to consider while on activities. Oddballs' is happy to accommodate alternative family dining times and to prepare simple food for children. They have games in the sitting area and reference books that will help to entertain and illuminate the children's experience.

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GENERAL INFORMATION

MmaTsebe Tented Camp invites travelers to an exclusive safari experience, open all year round and perfectly suited for adventure in every season. Nestled within a secluded 25-hectare private concession along the Mbudi River in Khwai, this hidden gem offers an intimate connection with nature in one of Botswana's most game-rich regions.

Located at the crossroads of wilderness icons—Chobe National Park, Savuti, and Moremi Game Reserve—the camp offers effortless access to some of the most sought-after wildlife viewing areas in Northern Botswana.

Whether it's tracking big cats on morning drives or gliding silently through the delta on a traditional mokoro, unforgettable encounters await.











Named after the legendary leopardess MmaTsebe—meaning "marked ear"—the camp honors her fierce spirit and maternal legacy.

Known for her rare daylight hunts and unwavering devotion to her cubs, she was a symbol of strength, grace, and wild beauty. That same essence defines every moment at MmaTsebe Tented Camp.

ACCOMODATION

An authentic sensitively appointed tented bushcamp with comfortable, yet generous proportions, bedrooms $6 \times 4m \ \theta$ bathrooms $4 \times 2m$. All tents have fans and mosquito nets over the beds.

Nine en-suite tents, all of which can be made up as a double or twin, please specify preference. Five mobile single beds are available and can be inserted to any of the tents to make up a triple.







Only one additional bed per tent may be added for children 8-11 years. Children: Children aged 8 and older are welcome.

For those aged 8–11, a private vehicle is required for participation in game drives (additional cost).

MmaTsebe Tented Camp also has one guides unit.





MEALS

Every meal at MmaTsebe Tented Camp is a moment to savor—delicious cuisine paired with uninterrupted views of the wild. A centrally located and welcoming dining area brings guests together to enjoy freshly prepared meals crafted from wholesome, responsibly sourced local ingredients.

Special dietary preferences are gladly catered for, including vegetarian, vegan, gluten-free, and lactose-free options—ensuring every guest is well looked after. Because no one goes hungry on safari—especially not here.









ACTIVITIES

All activities are hosted by expert guides and tracker teams. Departure times and duration is tailored to season, sightings and guest interests.

Game Drives:

Explore the surrounding wilderness in open safari vehicles, accommodating up to 7 guests per drive. Cooler boxes are stocked with sundowners or early morning refreshments to suit your preference.

Mokoro Excursions:
Glide quietly along the waterways in a traditional dugout canoe, soaking in the tranquility and spotting wildlife from a unique perspective.



SITATUNGA'S EDGE

Explore the Delta by motorboat

Full Day Excursion - *Extra charges apply Available on min. 3 nights stays



Begin your day with a 6.30 AM departure from camp, heading out on a scenic morning game drive to the Hippo Pools near Moremi's North Gate. After a coffee and tea break, continue to Xakanaxa Boat Station for the next leg of your journey.









From 11.30 AM to 2.00 PM, cruise the Okavango Delta aboard a double-decker safari boat. The lower deck offers close-up views of crystal-clear channels and abundant birdlife, while the upper deck provides panoramic sightings of game—possibly including the rare Sitatunga antelope, found in high numbers here. Enjoy a picnic lunch and refreshing drinks onboard as you explore one of the world's most extraordinary ecosystems.


Return to camp via afternoon game drive, arriving by 6.30 PM.

Optional: Upgrade to a scenic helicopter transfer for a later start and aerial views of the Delta. Return via game drive.















FACILITIES

- Swimming Pool: Cool off and enjoy downtime at the camp's refreshing pool—best paired with a gin & tonic, a guest favorite.
- Lounge & Dining Areas: Social spaces invite relaxation and conversation, offering shaded comfort and beautiful views of the surrounding wilderness
- Power & Charging: Solar-powered 220v electricity runs 24/7, with charging stations in tents and the main area. International plug points are available—bringing personal adaptors is recommended.





- Wi-Fi: Available in select areas for essential communication.
 Guests are encouraged to enjoy device-free time in communal spaces and to download media before arrival.
- Bugs & Mosquitoes: Wildlife includes insects and mosquitoes. Preventative measures are in place, but guests should consult a healthcare provider regarding malaria precautions and bring insect repellent.
- Medical: Comprehensive travel insurance is required. A medic is on call, staff are first-aid trained, and each tent includes a 24-hour emergency horn.
